WHEREAS, co-operatives — businesses owned and governed by their members — empower people to join together to meet shared needs and goals, from providing healthy food and affordable housing to offering financial services, healthcare, energy, and employment opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, more than 65,000 co-operatives in the United States serve one in three Americans, while globally nearly three million co-operatives support over 280 million jobs and 12% of the world's population through community-centered enterprise; and,

WHEREAS, co-operatives play a major role in New Hampshire's economy and reflect our state's enduring values of independence, innovation, and collaboration, improving quality of life and strengthening communities across the Granite State; and,

WHEREAS, the Neighboring Food Co-op Association and the National Co-operative Business Association have endorsed this year's theme, "Co-operatives Build a Better World," celebrating the power of co-operatives to foster sustainable and resilient communities:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KELLY AYOTTE, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim OCTOBER 2025 as CO-OP MONTH in the State of New Hampshire, and encourage all citizens to recognize and celebrate the vital contributions of co-operatives to our communities, our economy, and our shared future.
